

ADULT MINISTRY

Literacy and Biblical literacy are important to reading and understanding the Word of God. Discipling adults in the Word of God is vital to their spiritual growth and key to understanding and applying God's will for their lives.

Local champions open the Bible to lead men and women to the truths in God's Word through literacy classes, Bible study groups, and prison ministry.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Trained local champions introduce children to the love of Jesus Christ through Bible Clubs, Vacation Bible School, Summer Camps, and even partnerships with national governments to work in existing public education systems.

When children meet Jesus, their hearts are transformed. And best of all, they take their new Bible and the life-giving message of Jesus Christ home to their families!

PERSECUTED CHURCH MINISTRY

Believers in countries where it is dangerous to be a Christian ask for Bibles and our prayers. The Living Word of God builds up communities of oppressed believers and strengthens their resolve and equips them to share the Gospel with others.


In the midst of persecution, there is tremendous victory as the Gospel is shared and many come to know the hope and comfort of Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour.

These men and women receive mentorship from experienced leaders, tools for sharing God's Word, and hands-on guidance to start local churches where there are currently none.

AFRICA A MACHANICA OF PECCE



It's not an easy thing to be in Uganda. Once the centre of a civil war leading to the death of over 300,000 people, and the disruption of two million more, so much healing is needed: physical, emotional, and spiritual.

Edwin says, "Like many others, my life was personally affected by war, and the effect trickles down to the children. This breaks my heart."

Edwin joined the Children's Ministry training program, made possible through your support, when the program was first offered in Gulu District near Kampala, Uganda. He served as a pastor at the church that hosted the training.

"This training is unique. It is hands-on and clearly demonstrates the steps in a child's spiritual life as they progress: from the time they begin their personal relationship with Jesus to when they become active participants in increasing the kingdom of God. **My view of children's ministry changed from being confined to a church program on Sunday to an everyday, everywhere service for children both inside and outside the church building."**

Inspired, Edwin was organizing school outreaches, placing children's Bibles—made possible because of you—and starting a community Bible Club to disciple new believers. The ministry grew, and they saw some of the new believing children, and their families, joining church on Sunday.

"Then," says Edwin, "I clearly heard the Lord instructing me to relocate to Kitgum, my home district, a two-hour journey, and serve the children there. I realized the call had always been there, but I did not have the courage to say yes to Him until now. My training and new experience gave me peace with accepting His call!"

"The Lord granted us favour. We soon attracted the attention of youth in the community. We met in an open space with our new friends, in the shade of a huge tree. We began community Bible clubs and engaged the children in worship activities including

music, drama, singing, and instruments. We formed a sports club. Confidence came from the Lord, and from the training He blessed me with," Edwin reported.

"I feel called, and now equipped, to help raise up a transformed generation and have peace in our land. That is our journey now."

Finding Peace

Research indicates more than 40% of Canadian inmates are from the Indigenous community and in some prisons this statistic grows to 80%. Literacy rates within the prison system are at a grade 8 level, but the Indigenous inmate population has even lower than average literacy and numeracy rates, along with difficulty in comprehension and written communication skills.

Learning about this community helps broaden our understanding of the human story and respond more intentionally to the needs of inmates. Finding a way to communicate the Gospel message in a way that honours their cultural and literacy needs is vital to bringing about life transformation and hope through the Living Word of God.





an Indigenous author and advocate created Bible studies that respond to the literacy rates, learning styles, and cultural needs of these inmates.

Through your support, author Randi-Lynn was commissioned to write the first Bible correspondence study series designed specifically for Indigenous inmates.

A born and raised Métis who was part of a Christian Indigenous family and community in Calgary, Randi-Lynn completed a Justice Studies diploma to work in the Canadian Correctional System specifically with

Indigenous people. She has a passion for her faith, family, and her people. She is excited to be working in ministry that will bring healing to those within the correctional system.

Randi-Lynn's first study on the topic of God as Creator is true to the Word of God while still honouring her Indigenous cultural background. She recognizes that in her community, most of



the confusion lies in the belief that the beautiful diversity within Indigenous cultural practices cannot be honoured within the Christian faith. She is working hard to address that tension.

Vivid Indigenous illustrations help respond to the literacy and comprehension needs of inmates, but also help to connect



words to the cultural importance of art. "For my community, art is a way to tell our story. Historically, we painted our horses, our teepees, our utensils, and so much more. Art takes words on a page and draws our readers into the story of God as Creator."

Randi-Lynn has a calling to help her community find peace by learning about the transforming power of Jesus to heal generational trauma and brokenness.

Passing the Peace


Marek grew up in Kalisz, Poland in the 1970's. His parents had a troubled relationship, marked by violence. As he got older, Marek rebelled, indulging in smoking, drugs, and crime with friends. He went to prison multiple times, becoming increasingly callous. Even after marriage and fatherhood, his life didn't change.

He hit rock bottom when his actions drove his wife and children away, and this led to a suicide attempt in prison. Divorced and struggling, Marek attended prison church meetings out of desperation and curiosity, eventually connecting with a sincere former gangster, Piotr, who had turned to Christ. Piotr's influence led Marek to pray for his own salvation.

Marek's life changed as he began studying the Bible and applying its teachings to his life. He shifted from self-centeredness to

> caring for others. He passed on the peace of Christ that he had found to fellow prisoners, helping them to discover faith in Jesus and connect them with the correspondence Bible studies made possible through your support.





Marek's faith grew, leading to baptism. Though he remains in prison for past crimes, Marek continues to share his testimony, help others, and study the Bible. He learned to find gratitude even in difficult circumstances, understanding that God can turn challenges into opportunities for growth.

God has the power to free people from sin and addictions—Marek knows this. He urges everyone he meets to open their hearts to Jesus, who forgives and offers grace. Through faith, even the darkest situations can lead to positive change.

Dear Fellow Worker in Christ,

Myanmar, Mexico, Ukraine, South Sudan, Ethiopia. These countries all have at least two things in common. Sadly, they are all nations dealing with conflict, either internally or from outside aggressors. They are also all countries in which Bible League Canada partners with national champions to bring the peace of Jesus to their own people.

Perhaps never before in the history of Bible League Canada has our work been more necessary, and at the same time, by the grace of God, had more of an impact in **bringing the peace of Christ to nations and individual lives.**

A medical doctor in a closed country in Africa that has been at war for many years, who for the first 65 years of his life was a devoted Muslim, became a follower of Christ in 2023 through our partner ministry in his country. After experiencing peace and the assurance of eternal life for the first time, he said, "I will play my role to bring peace among my Muslim brothers and tell them about Jesus."

There is only one answer to the cry of billions of people around the world for peace, both within their nations and within their hearts, and that is the person of Jesus Christ.

In Psalm 75:3 we read this promise from our Creator, **"When the earth and all its people quake, it is I who hold its pillars firm."** Through your generosity, we were able to come alongside thousands of peacemakers who brought the peace that only Jesus offers to nations and individual hearts. Hundreds of thousands of individuals experienced what Jesus promised in John 14:27, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid."

Young Sarla loved to play tricks and mean pranks on others and would secretly steal fruits and flowers from the neighbours. When disciplined, Sarla would react with rudeness.

Francisco says that one of the most important parts of his training is the focus on mentoring the leaders in their new churches. Through this mentoring, they will see these new churches grow and multiply.


To have members of the church serving the community is an important component of spiritual growth. Francisco loves that the neighbourhood sees the church not only preaching the Gospel but also living out their faith in the community. Seven days a week, not just one. His church focuses on caring for the at-risk children on the streets in four areas: their spiritual life, their nutrition, their emotional health, and helping them learn a trade. This has impacted the children in such a positive way that the parents take an interest, and the community as a whole has more respect for the church. The programs grow, giving more opportunity to proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ to their neighbours!

Peacemaker

Koem Lin had received training to start new churches, thanks to your support. She loves reaching out to new people. Travelling on her motorbike, she journeyed to Kep, the smallest province in Cambodia and started to pray for people and share the Good News of Jesus. As she gained their trust, the people in one village started to tell her of the family just outside town, with dangerous children.

The father lived with three adult children that were demon possessed. The two girls would run into the mountains and eat pebbles, terrorizing anyone that came in their path. The whole village knew them and their brother to be violent and aggressive. Their father was filled with shame and could no longer speak.

When Koem approached the house, she saw the young man was bound up by thick chains. His father had scars all over his body from caring for his son. Koem was determined to be a peacemaker for this hurting family, and committed to praying Scripture with their father for 30 days.



"Peacemakers who sow in peace reap a harvest of righteousness."



After the first week, his voice was restored. The next week, first one daughter, then the other, woke as if from sleep, and were peaceful. The Word of God had delivered them! The Holy Spirit had entered their home and their lives—bringing peace and hope!

But the son was still violent and dangerous. Koem stayed two more weeks, praying daily and reading Scripture to him, until finally he was calm. They unchained his hands and he calmly ate a meal. They removed the leg chains and his father, with tears of joy running down his face, bathed and dressed him.

The village was amazed at what had happened. People from all over the province came to see if it was true. Many came looking for healing and peace in their own lives. Koem was able to share the message of the power of Jesus' name over and over again. Soon every village in the province of Kep had heard the Gospel. House churches were started in each village. This small village in the smallest province in Cambodia had a great impact.

With all praise and thanks to the Lord, all three children are now being discipled. And their father, eager to pass this peace of Christ to others, is being mentored to be one of the leaders for the new house church in the village.
