Local champions open the Bible to lead men and women to the truths in God's Word through literacy classes, Bible study groups, and prison ministry.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Trained local champions introduce children to the love of Jesus Christ through Bible Clubs, Vacation Bible School, Summer Camps, and even partnerships with national governments to work in existing public education systems.

When children meet Jesus, their hearts are transformed. And best of all, they take their new Bible and the life-giving message of Jesus Christ home to their families!

PERSECUTED CHURCH MINISTRY

Believers in countries where it is dangerous to be a Christian ask for Bibles and our prayers. The Living Word of God builds up communities of oppressed believers to strengthen their resolve, and equip them to share the Gospel with others.


In the midst of persecution, there is tremendous victory as the Gospel is shared and many come to know the hope and comfort of Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour.

STARTING NEW CHURCHES

With genuine faith and deep love for their neighbours, these local champions can spark powerful movements within their communities. These men and women receive mentorship from experienced leaders, tools for sharing God's Word, and hands-on guidance to start local churches where there are currently none.





Regina's passion for Children's Ministry has opened a new door in her home county of Machakos in Kenya. As the Children's Ministry Coordinator, Regina has dedicated herself to training and equipping a new generation of workers to guide young hearts toward God in an ever-changing world — all made possible through your support.

The impact of the training was immediate and significant. A pastor from a local church, remarked, "My participation has added to my knowledge. I'm going to mobilize my teachers and leaders so that we can have a training program in our church, providing deep knowledge and understanding."

Regina's vision extends beyond just training workers. "To truly transform children's lives," Regina says, "the entire family must be involved." One participant

declared, "We have been trained and are ready to go back and conquer!" Yet, they also recognized the journey ahead, asking, "How can we help the parents in our churches?"

Regina's initial step of faith has sparked a movement, igniting passion for Children's Ministry across her region. God's presence is evident as the plans take shape for parenting seminars and ongoing support programs. Through her dedication and vision, Regina has become a catalyst for change, ensuring that the body of Christ is built up through effective ministry to children, young people, and families.

Armed with new knowledge, skills, and crucially, Bibles, she continues to train other dedicated workers to meet the spiritual needs of the young people in their care. Regina's tireless efforts are helping young souls grow strong in their faith and identity in Christ, ensuring a bright future for the church and its youngest members.

Spending Time in God's Word

Why would Taylor and 200 other university students from across Canada devote a week of their lives to a Spring Scripture Camp?

For some students, it meant asking for an exam to be rescheduled or even losing a week of work. Still, at the end of term, when energy and finances were scarce, they boarded planes, cars, and buses, travelling for three to six hours to attend the camp in their region.

"Living a very chaotic student life, it's sometimes hard to spend a ton of time in Scripture," says Taylor, a university student in B.C. "You're either busy with school, work, or life, while also trying to stay connected with God."

This past May, your support made it possible for students to attend a Scripture Camp to

be equipped in their faith and to learn how to lead similar studies on their campuses.

"Every time I step into Scripture it is special," says Taylor. "There is a lot of wisdom, comfort, and confidence in the Bible. I find that when I take the time to study and apply Scripture to my life, there are noticeable changes in my heart and mind. I feel connected again."

Fifty staff from InterVarsity, a Canadian partner of Bible League Canada, are trained to lead the Scripture camps using a variety

of methods, including inductive manuscript group study, teaching, and contemplative Lectio Divina. Together, staff and students spend three to six hours a day in Scripture, with other time given to prayer and worship, fellowship over meals and recreational activities.

"Spending five days in intense study of Scripture was incredibly beneficial to me," says Max, an Alberta university student. "Reading the Bible helps us to know God. The more time we spend in God's presence, the better we understand His Word. I think personal study and prayer are vital; it makes our relationship with God a personal thing. But studying and praying in community adds other dimensions: accountability and different points of view. Sometimes you're not getting it, but someone else can explain it or at least get you closer."

This year, the camps focused on Psalms, Job, Mark, Luke, James, and Revelation. At one camp, students traced the theme of God's relational presence through the arc of Scripture from Genesis to Revelation.

"I love how Scripture camp so consistently changes young people's lives," says Hogan, a campus minister. "From new conviction around the Gospel truth to new power in prayer to new hopes and aspirations for their futures, I am so encouraged every year by what Christ is doing in the hearts of students. They do not walk away unchanged by the Gospel!"

"I want to invest my life into bringing the kingdom of God to my city." These are the words of a committed, trained evangelist, Jonasz, in Poland.


"When my 6-year-old son came home from school and told me that I had lied to him. I couldn't believe my ears. 'Daddy, you told me Jesus is king, and every knee will bow down to him. But when I told my friends about this, they told me I was being a silly little boy.' That is the mindset of the culture I am working in — parents, and their children, who don't know who God is."

And so, Jonasz, together with his wife and young son, is dedicated to bringing the kingdom of God to his city, one heart at a time.

With their strategic Adult Ministry program, one-to-one discipleship is the cornerstone. A mature Christian mentors a new believer.

giving them a Bible provided through your support. Another believer gathers the new believers in weekly groups to be discipled together and hold each other accountable. Each of these new believers is equipped and empowered to share the Good News with people in their family, neighbourhood, and workplace. The church grows. No one rests in these pews.

Jonasz holds up a hand-crafted poster that has deep meaning for their church. It has tiny hearts lined up in the shape of a cross, and every person in the church is represented by one of these hearts.

Branching out from each heart are the names of people they are praying for, talking to, or inviting to church.

This living document challenges them to remain on mission. Even Jonasz's young son is on there, praying for two people at his school.

One heart at a time, this committed group of believers is transforming their community. As their church grows, the Spirit of God, moving through their efforts, demonstrates to their community that He is with them. Marriages are healed, lives are filled with new purpose, and wayward children are returning; these are the unmistakable fruit of God's presence. All praise to Him!

Dear Fellow Worker in Christ,

Even in some of the most challenging places in the world in 2024, God makes His presence known.

In Uganda, 60 Children's Ministry workers from five different denominations were trained to reach the hearts and lives of the young people throughout the Yumbe District Refugee Settlement, filled with South Sudanese who have fled the ongoing conflict in their homeland. The report we received rejoiced that "those trained expressed their gratitude for the training, feeling joyful and transformed."

In 2024, through the regional, national, and local partners of Bible League Canada, God made His presence known in almost 50 countries around the world.

And we know that the presence of the Holy Spirit always leads to Kingdom impact. Jesus said in Acts 1:8, "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." The presence and power of the Holy Spirit always go hand in hand with ministry and mission.

When God's presence came with power on the Day of Pentecost, 3,000 were added to the Church. Through our Spirit-filled and Spirit-directed local champions around the world, we are seeing the same kind of impact. On May 31, 2024, our partner in Thailand baptized 2,525 new followers of Jesus!

Throughout Latin America and Canada, Eastern Europe and South East Asia, India and Africa, the presence of the Living God is now manifest through local churches, often where local churches have never existed before and the Gospel has never been present. Through children's programs and adult literacy classes, and among those persecuted because they love Jesus, God has manifested His presence.

There is still so much to do, and with your support, Bible League Canada continues with the mandate given by the God who is present. As the apostle Paul said in Philippians 3:14, "I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus."

A Life Transformed

As a girl, Bisma dreamt of going to school and being educated, but her parents had very traditional beliefs and education was not a priority for a daughter. Instead, Bisma spent her childhood learning domestic chores like cleaning, laundry, and cooking.

When Bisma married, her husband worked in the fields as she raised their three. children and managed the home. Bisma's children attended school, but she was ashamed that she couldn't help them with their homework.



All too often, her family faced unexpected financial hardships when she was taken advantage of in the marketplace or at the bank. Borrowing money from lenders, often at very high interest rates, sent them further and further into debt. Bisma had no idea how to protect herself from crooked money lenders or apply to reputable lenders. This made her feel hopeless and unhappy with her life.

One day, Bisma heard about a new Adult Literacy Class in her community and signed up immediately! From the start, she was highly motivated to learn and actively participated in class.

Bisma enjoyed interacting with the teacher and other students, and never missed a class. With hard work and determination. she was soon reading, writing, and performing basic math.

The practical learning from the Adult Literacy Class, made possible through your support, was life-changing for Bisma, but best of all was learning about Jesus.

Bisma loved reading the Bible stories, and after experiencing God's presence in her personal life, she knew she wanted to follow Jesus as her Lord and Saviour. Now. Bisma reads the Bible with her children, and prays with them.

The Literacy Class also offered several special programs where Bisma learned about health and hygiene and how to manage her finances. Now the family no longer borrows money. Bisma started boiling their drinking water and has implemented many new cleaning routines that promote health and well-being. To ensure nutritious food, she even began growing her own vegetables.

Each night, Bisma would share what she learned with her children, and was excited that she could now help them with their schoolwork, and they could help their mother with hers!

When Bisma successfully completed the year-long course and held the certificate in her hands, she said it was one of the happiest days of her life.

This encounter with God also sparked a strong desire to share this Good News with others. Leonel, and soon, his wife as well, went out into their community, but felt ill-equipped. They needed training. They needed Bibles.

Through your support, Leonel and Belkis were able to receive the training and equipping to start new churches, and were excited when the networking and church planting strategies began to bear fruit, almost immediately!

To date, they have started new churches in seven neighbourhoods where there was not a church before. They reach out to the neighbourhood and joyfully disciple people in the Word of God. Soon, new leaders are being raised up, and many new people are coming to these churches. Now, some of these new leaders request training so they can move into other neighbourhoods and share Jesus. And this is how the presence of the Lord moves forward

Pastor Leonel is eager to share, "We have been greatly blessed because of the tools we were given. And this has had a great impact. It has been a great blessing for improving our work in other communities. I thank God because He has allowed me to understand these resources and put them into practice. This helps us move forward. Now we have a lot of people who are learning so they can begin work in other communities and start new churches."


Brimming with joy, Nan tells about her baptism. "I was excited and very happy about being baptized on this day."

thrilled to announce soft openings for new stores in Burlington, ON and Summerside, PE (through the Charlottetown store), and Cranbrook, BC has successfully opened a satellite location in Creston. Additionally, our Ponoka, AB location is in the final stages of construction for relocation, marking another important step in our mission's growth.

As we look to the future, we remain committed to the vision and values that drive us, and we are excited to see how God will continue to bless the work we do together!
