#### **Bibles for Africa**

In Africa, local champions have been discipling new believers, but without Bibles. During the Spring, **you made it possible to place 94,000 Bibles in the hands of new believers** excited for their very own copy of God's Word! ### **Reaching Kids in Canada**

This summer, local churches ran STEM Bible Clubs (STEM stands for Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) which uniquely integrated STEM activities with biblical teachings, providing an exciting and impactful experience for children aged 4 to 13. Children explored and appreciated the physical aspects of the world God has created while discovering more about Jesus. Your support made it possible to train volunteers to share the Gospel with 2,100 children, and give them a Bible!

### **Reaching Kids Around the World**

This past summer, kids all over the world attended Summer Camps, Values Education Programs, Bible Clubs, and VBS programs. Each program was unique, but they all have two things in common: Kids and Jesus. Starting them off with Jesus, on the way they should go, is life-changing.

## **One Body**

No one knew Wang's\* story.

What they did know, and experienced, was her critical nature. One member of Wang's house church shares, "When we first met, she would always talk about how others were not good—their speech, actions, preaching, praising, or praying. She would point out flaws in everything others did, and she believed that only what she did was right. If someone mentioned that perhaps her words were inappropriate or harsh, she would become angry."

As a member of a small church that meets in secret, it can be dangerous to be at odds with each other. No one knew why Wang was so critical, but it had to stop. The need for unity in this church body was vital.

Her fellow church members did not give up on her. She was their sister in Christ. Relying on God and His Word, they chose to love her through it.

"Thank the Lord for His leading. We began to speak to her about the merits and positive aspects of others. We read the Bible together to guide her (and ourselves) on how to put others before self, what humility and pride were, and how to recognize issues and accept correction and guidance from others. It took patience, but we started to see a change in her. She began to praise others when speaking and started using words of encouragement and appreciation. We are so blessed that we have access to the Bible to guide us."

This small church continues to meet together and praise God. They know that through His Word people's hearts are changed!

# Feeling the Love of God

Juan volunteers as a Values Education Program leader in the Philippines. His training and the Bibles he is able to give to students are because of your support. He loves sharing his experience, and how the Spirit of God is moving in these classrooms.

"Yeah, the students. At first, when they are getting to know us, it's mostly about classroom management, and how to deal with the students. But as we share the Gospel, and the Values lessons students can relate to, we begin to see changes. Sure, some of the students shrug us off and say, 'You're just teaching us a lesson,' but some of them are crying, some of them are feeling the love of God. And some of them are wanting prayer."

Sharing Jesus with these students and teaching them how to apply lessons from the Bible to their lives is so important to Juan. "By sharing the Word of God, I believe we are seeing a powerful effect on them. Even in the schools where they give us the last hour of the day,



we still teach with energy and enthusiasm, and they see our passion for Jesus and respond to it. But it is not just us, we know it is the touch of God. The students are asking, 'Can you teach again tomorrow?' They want to hear this Good News every day!

"For students, the Bible is very important, because it will impact them so much. It has the power to change your life. For example, me! I became a Christian when I was young, and I was taught from the Bible. When I was a little older, and a bully, the Lord reminded me, 'My son, I love you. Do you know that I also love those you are bullying? The love I have for you is the same love I have for them.'

"I stood up to my friends when they wondered why I'm not the bully anymore. I was shy to share, but I had to. The impact of the Bible is life-changing. And that's why, even as a bully, the Lord gave me wisdom to challenge the status quo, and change.

"So, if my students hear the Word of God, they can be transformed, too.

"Children are our future. They will be the next leaders, the next mayors, the next president! If we give them this core foundation of biblical values as the basis for their life, they will be good leaders. They will be the future of the Philippines!"


# An Answer to Prayer

anyone who crosses his path. As a farmer, Geda had a young man named Gemu working with him as an assistant farmer. Gemu came to Christ because of the change he saw in Geda. Today in the church, Gemu sits nearby, delighted that he too has received a Bible of his own.

"I was praying that God would give me an Oromo Bible one day, and that day was a blessed and special day."

Having his own Bible has empowered Geda. How many more lives will be touched through his testimony?
